Special issue on Zoosporic Parasites

High current interest in the topic – Focus on:

- Zoosporic parasites (aquatic fungi and fungi-like microorganisms),
- The relation with their hosts (aquatic primary producers) and main drivers of infections
- In natural ecosystems (particularly the effects due to climate change), experimental tests, industrial algal biotech production etc.









Proposed timeline

Meeting Editorial Board - After the workshop

> Define scope and target journals

Contact editors of indexed journals (ISI or Scopus) - By the end of the year

- > Assess interest in publishing a book review on the topic
- > Negotiate conditions (e.g. fast track one discounted OA article for a student)

Special issue announcement and call for abstracts

> January-June 2025

Open submission

> July 2025 - 2026 - Can be extended until end of 2026












Scientific publication (reviews, scientific papers, results of STSM)
